- Operates Australia's largest National Equipment Database (NED) in with more than 20,000 products.

Importance of independent living

Preference amongst older age bracket to 'Age in Place' remain living

in their home rather than entering residential aged care, even when ageing impacts on independence

'One Billion people need assistive products today and more than two billion people around the world are expected to need at least one assistive product by 2030.'













Finding a joint solution

- Indigo identified a gap in the market for provision of Goods, Equipment and Assistive Technology (GEAT) to support independent living.
- In addition to increasing pressures across aged care and health services, the Australian Government could see areas across Australia where provision of GEAT services were lacking.
- Joint solution was to enable Indigo platform to perform a wrap around service for provision of GEAT across Australia, funded through the Commonwealth Home Support Program.







- Program established as a final solution in meeting a gap in GEAT provision nationally.
- Success of the program to date has meant an additional \$35 million in funding for 2022/23 and an extension of program scope.

- geat2GO platform is underpinned by NED: the National Equipment Database which aims to encourage greater use of Assistive Technology.
